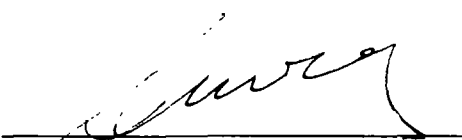

1. On 31 October 2008, Pre-Trial Chamber II rendered its "Decision on Defence Counsel's "Request for conditional stay of proceedings""¹ rejecting the Defence request.
2. Pre-Trial Chamber II, while extending the deadline for the submission of all participants' observations on the question of admissibility,² ordered the Prosecution to disclose to the Defence and to file confidentially paragraphs 1 to 3 of the "Prosecutor's Amended Application for Warrants of Arrest Under Article 58"³ ("information") as well as Exhibits A, B and C annexed thereto ("exhibits").⁴
