Trial Chamber VI of the International Criminal Court ('Court'), in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bosco Ntaganda* ('Ntaganda case'), issues the following 'Decision notifying the election of the Presiding Judge'.

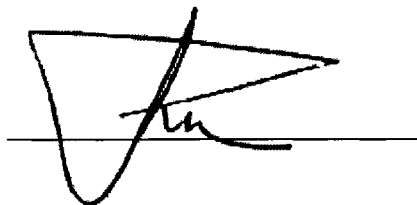
1. On 18 July 2014, the Presidency of the Court constituted Trial Chamber VI, composed of Judge Kuniko Ozaki, Judge Robert Fremr and Judge Geoffrey Henderson, and referred to it the *Ntaganda* case.¹ The judges of Trial Chamber VI elected Judge Robert Fremr as Presiding Judge.²
2. On 18 March 2015, the Presidency re-composed Trial Chamber VI to be comprised of Judge Kuniko Ozaki, Judge Robert Fremr and Judge Chang-ho Chung.³ Pursuant to Regulation 13(2) of the Regulations of the Court, the judges of Trial Chamber VI, in its new composition, elected a Presiding Judge and **HEREBY DECLARE** that Judge Robert Fremr is the Presiding Judge.

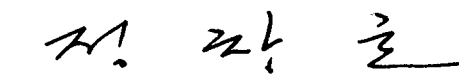
