The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”):

NOTING the oral decision of Pre-Trial Chamber III scheduling the confirmation of charges hearing¹ for Laurent Gbagbo for 18 June 2012 issued on 5 December 2011;

NOTING the Presidency’s “Decision on the constitution of Pre-Trial Chambers and the assignment of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Darfur, Sudan and Côte d’Ivoire situations”² dated 15 March 2012;

NOTING rule 13 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

INFORMS the Chamber as follows:

1. On 28 May 2012, the Registry received by fax a communication from the Counsel representing the Republic of Côte d’Ivoire requesting the authorization for representatives of the Republic of Côte d’Ivoire to attend the confirmation of charges hearing on 18 June 2012.
2. The Registry received the confirmation from the Ivorian authorities stating the two Counsel had been appointed by the State of Côte d’Ivoire to represent its interest before the International Criminal Court.
