The Registrar of the International Criminal Court ("the Court"),

NOTING the Registry's report on the organization of the participation of victims, filed confidential *ex parte* only available to the Registry on 23 January 2012 and public on 6 February 2012 ("Report");¹

NOTING the Decision of the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber III ("Single Judge") on issues related to the victims' application process, dated 6 February 2012 ordering the Registry *inter alia* to propose to the Chamber an application form that could be used for the purpose of encouraging collective applications ("Decision of the Single Judge");²

NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rules 85 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), regulations 23, 86, 88 of the Regulations of the Court ("Regulations") and regulation 104 of the Regulations of the Registry;

TRANSMITS to the Chamber the Registry's draft partly collective application form that has not yet been submitted to the Presidency for approval as required by regulation 23(2) of the Regulations, along with a report explaining the proposed partly collective approach explored by the Registry, in compliance with the Decision of the Single Judge.
