NOTING the “Decision Convening Status Conferences”¹ issued on 9 December 2001;

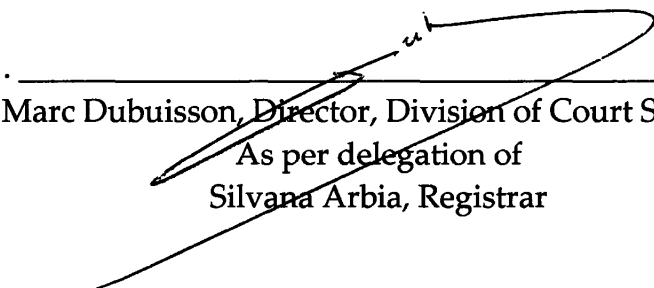
NOTING the Status Conference (the “Status Conference”) held on 14 December 2011;
