Other

1. Pursuant to Trial Chamber I's decision of 13 February 2015,¹ the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") disclosed to the Defence of Charles Blé Goudé, 767 items of incriminating evidence, 15 items of potentially exculpatory evidence and 519 items pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"). The redactions applied to these disclosures are in accordance with the protocol adopted in the GBAGBO case.²
2. The Prosecution additionally provided to the Defence the list of the names and corresponding pseudonyms of investigators whose identity may now be disclosed, as it was provided in the Laurent GBAGBO case.³
3. The disclosed material was provided in a format that complies with the e-Court protocol as approved at the Pre-Trial stage.

Request for Confidentiality

4. Annexes A,⁴ B⁵, C⁶ and D⁷ appended to this communication contain the disclosure notes provided to the Defence. The Prosecution requests that these annexes be received as "Confidential" since they relate to *inter partes* disclosure.

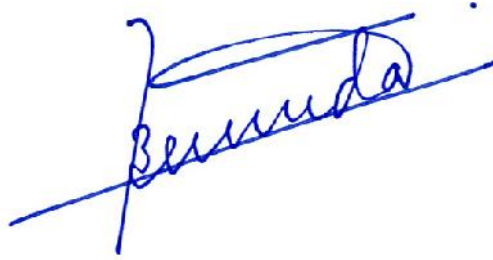
