The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”),

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision notified on 11 June 2014 in the case *The Prosecutor v. Charles Blé Goudé* (the “Case”), whereby the Single Judge *inter alia* admitted, as victims in the Case, 198 victims already participating in the case *The Prosecutor v. Laurent Gbagbo*, and appointed the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”) as common legal representative of these victims (the “First Decision”);¹

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision notified on 1 August 2014, in which the Single Judge decided *inter alia* to extend the mandate of the OPCV to 271 additional victims (the “Second Decision”);²

NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1) and 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

NOTIFIES the parties and participants that, pursuant to the Single Judge’s First and Second Decisions, the OPCV represents 469 victims admitted to participate in the confirmation of charges hearing and in the related proceedings in the Case as listed in the Annex appended hereto.
