1. The Prosecution notifies Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) of its disclosure, on 22 August 2014, of 130 incriminating documents,¹ three Rule 77 documents² and four potentially exculpatory documents.³ This material was disclosed pursuant to the Chamber’s decision of 11 July 2014.⁴
2. Out of the 130 items disclosed as incriminating documents, 48 were disclosed with Rule 81(2) and/or Rule 81(4) redactions to their image and 89, with redactions to their metadata. 27 of the disclosed documents have previously been disclosed pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) in the present case. These documents were provided to the Defence in a separate disclosure package.⁵ Out of the three items disclosed pursuant to Rule 77, one was disclosed with Rule 81(2) and Rule 81(4) redactions to its image and one with redactions to its metadata. All of these *proprio motu* redactions were applied pursuant to decision ICC-02/11-02/11-67, paragraph 12.
3. The disclosed material was provided in a format that complies with the eCourt protocol approved by the Chamber.
