Introduction

1. On 14 April 2014, the Single Judge, issued the “Decision establishing a system for disclosure of evidence” (“Decision”), ordering the Prosecution, *inter alia*, to file in the record of the case the Document containing the charges (“DCC”) and List of evidence (“LoE”) which it intends to rely on for the confirmation of the charges hearing.¹
2. On 11 July 2014, the date by which the Prosecution was required to submit its DCC and LoE was postponed to 22 August 2014.²
3. The Prosecution hereby annexes its *Document de notification des charges* and *Inventaire des éléments de preuve à charge*.³

Confidentiality

4. Pursuant to Regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court, the Prosecution files Annexes 2 and 3 as confidential, since these documents pertain to evidentiary matters which are to be treated as confidential. The Prosecution will file a public redacted version of Annex 2 as soon as practicable.
