1. The Prosecution notifies Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) of its disclosure, on 11 August 2014, of 45 incriminating documents¹ pursuant to the Chamber’s decision of 11 July 2014² and 62 documents under Rule 77³ pursuant to the Chamber’s decision of 5 May 2014.⁴
