The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”),

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision on victims’ participation at the confirmation of charges hearing and in related proceedings in the case *The Prosecutor v. Charles Blé Goudé* (the “Case”) notified on 11 June 2014 (the “Decision of 11 June”),¹ ordering *inter alia*, the Registrar to transmit to the Chamber and the Prosecutor in unredacted form any new complete and relevant applications for participation as soon as possible and, if appropriate, on a continuous basis, no later than 11 July 2014;²

NOTING the Presidency’s Decision on the constitution of Pre-Trial Chambers, reconstituting *inter alia* Pre-Trial Chamber 1, notified on 3 July 2014;³

NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rules 85 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and regulations 23 *bis* and 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that by 30 June 2014,⁴ the VPRS has received a total of 145 new individual applications for participation in the proceedings, of which 130 have been assessed by the Registry to be complete and linked to the Case;

CONSIDERING that the annexes to the present document are notified with the status “Confidential *EX PARTE*, available only to the Registry and to the Prosecutor”, in accordance with the Decision of 11 June;⁵
