The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”),

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision on victims’ participation at the confirmation of charges hearing and in related proceedings in the case *The Prosecutor v. Charles Blé Goudé* (the “Case”) notified on 11 June 2014 (the “Decision of 11 June”),¹ ordering *inter alia*, the Registrar to transmit to the Defence in redacted form complete and relevant applications for participation in the proceedings from the 148 currently in the possession of the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the “VPRS”), no later than 30 June 2014;²

NOTING article 68 (1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16, 85 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and regulations 23 *bis* and 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the VPRS has received a total of 148 individual applications for participation in the proceedings, of which 147 have been assessed by the Registry to be complete and linked to the Case;

CONSIDERING that the annexes to the present document are notified with the status “Confidential *EX PARTE* available only to the Registry and to the Defence”, in accordance with the Decision of 11 June;³
