1. The Prosecution notifies Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) of its disclosure, on 6 June 2014, of 214 incriminating documents,¹ 162 Rule 77 documents² and three potentially exculpatory documents.³ This material was disclosed pursuant to the Chamber’s decision of 5 May 2014.⁴

2. Out of the 214 items disclosed as incriminating documents, 11 were disclosed with Rule 81(2) and/or Rule 81(4) redactions to their image and 152, with redactions to their metadata. Out of the 162 items disclosed as Rule 77 documents, five were disclosed with Rule 81(2) and/or Rule 81(4) redactions to their image and 113, with redactions to their metadata. One of the items disclosed as potentially exculpatory was disclosed with Rule 81(2) redactions to its metadata. All of these *proprio motu* redactions were applied pursuant to decision ICC-02/11-02/11-67, paragraph 12.

3. The disclosed material was provided in a format that complies with the eCourt protocol approved by the Chamber.
