Introduction

1. On 6 January 2012, Pre-Trial Chamber III issued, Under Seal, *ex parte*, Prosecution and Registry only, the “Decision on the Prosecutor’s Application Pursuant to Article 58 for a warrant of arrest against Charles Blé Goudé (“Article 58 Decision”).¹
2. On 30 September 2013, Pre-Trial Chamber I issued the “Decision reclassifying the warrant of arrest against Charles Blé Goudé and other documents”.² And in doing so, the Chamber ordered the Prosecutor to “file in the record of the case, by Friday, 18 October 2013, submissions on whether any redactions to the Article 58 Decision are necessary before it is made public.”

Submissions

3. The Prosecution is not requesting any redactions to the Article 58 Decision. It is appropriate that the Article 58 Decision be reclassified as Public.
