Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) provides notice of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute.

Disclosure of evidence

2. On 6 May 2015, the Prosecution disclosed a total of 9 items as incriminating evidence.
3. In accordance with the Trial Chamber’s “Decision on the Prosecution request for variation of time limit for disclosure of the report of one expert witness”,¹ on 6 May 2015, the Prosecution disclosed the expert report of Dr John Yuille, together with two appendixes to the report and Dr Yuille’s *curriculum vitae*. The Prosecution also formally disclosed the five transcripts of the 'Radio Candip' broadcasts, which were provided to the Defence by way of advance copies on 1 May 2015.

4. Annex A appended to this communication contains the list of the evidence disclosed to the Defence. The Prosecution requests that this annex be received as “Confidential” since it relates to *inter partes* disclosure.
