NOTING Trial Chamber VI’s (the “Chamber”) Decision on victims’ participation in trial proceedings notified on 6 February 2015 (the “Participation Decision”);¹

NOTING the Chamber’s oral ruling issued on 22 April 2015 during a status conference, ordering deadlines to be recalculated on the basis of a 7 July 2015 commencement date for trial;²

NOTING article 68 (1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 89(1) and 91(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23 *bis* and 86(8) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the annex to the present document is notified with the status “Confidential, available only to the Prosecution and the Defence” in accordance with the instructions provided by the Chamber at paragraph 24(iv) of the Participation Decision;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber in paragraph 24(ii) of the Participation Decision ordered the Registry to assess the applications into three groups³ on the basis of guidance provided by the Chamber in Section III(B) of the Participation Decision;

CONSIDERING that on 2 April 2015, the Registry transmitted 39 simplified application forms that it assessed as falling under Group C, with the necessary redactions applied, to the parties;⁴

CONSIDERING that the Chamber in paragraph 24(iv) of the Participation Decision ordered the Registry to transmit all simplified application forms it has assessed as falling under Group C, with any necessary redactions, to the parties;⁵

TRANSMITS to the parties one additional simplified application form falling under Group C.
