Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) provides notice of the disclosure of material falling within rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

Disclosure of evidence

2. On 11 May 2015, the Prosecution re-disclosed one item under rule 77.
3. In accordance with the Trial Chamber’s “Decision on the Prosecution request for redactions”¹ and following the Victims and Witnesses Unit’s confirmation that disclosure of screened individual P-0899’s identity can take place, the Prosecution re-disclosed his screening note without redactions previously applied to identifying information.
