NOTING the Decision on the Victims’ Participation in the Situation issued by Pre-Trial Chamber I (the “Chamber”), notified on 24 April 2015 (the “Decision of 24 April 2015”), whereby the Chamber *inter alia* appoints Ms Paolina Massidda from the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”) as legal representative of unrepresented victims who have communicated with the Court for the purposes of the proceedings under article 53 of the Statute;¹

NOTING article 68(1) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1), 90(2) to 90(5) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that the Registry has received 109 applications to participate in the proceedings and/or applications for reparations from unrepresented victims, which it has assessed as complete and linked to the Situation;

NOTIFIES the parties and participants that the OPCV represents 109 applicants listed in the annex appended to this filing for the purposes of the article 53 proceedings, in accordance with the Decision of 24 April 2015.
