1. The Office of the Prosecutor provides notice of the disclosure to the Defence teams of Laurent GBAGBO and Charles BLÉ GOUDÉ of 217 incriminating items¹ and 19 items pursuant to rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,² on 8 June 2015. The Prosecution also provided the GBAGBO Defence team with updated metadata in relation to 458 documents previously disclosed as incriminatory material.³
2. The incriminating material disclosed consists primarily of photos taken during the autopsy conducted on 6 May 2015 in relation to the 3 March 2011 incident.
3. The rule 77 items are all applications for participation of dual status witnesses, disclosed in accordance with Trial Chamber I's Decision on Victim Participation.⁴ All are disclosed with redactions to their image only, in accordance with decision ICC-02/11-01/11-737 ("Redaction Protocol").⁵ Those redactions marked 'B.3. LRV' are applied upon the request of the Legal Representative of Victims ("LRV"), and were the subject of a Request to maintain redactions,⁶ filed by the LRV on 8 June 2015.
4. The disclosed material was provided in a format that complies with the eCourt protocol as approved in the case.⁷

5. Annexes A⁸, B⁹, C,¹⁰ D¹¹ and E¹² appended to this communication contain the disclosure notes provided to the Defence. The Prosecution requests that these
