The Office of the Prosecutor provides notice of the re-disclosure to the Defence team for Charles BLÉ GOUDÉ of 550 incriminating items,<sup>1</sup> 39 potentially exonerating items<sup>2</sup> and 169 items pursuant to rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,<sup>3</sup> on 18 June 2015. These items, which had already been disclosed to the Defence, were re-disclosed with less redactions.
2. The Prosecution also provided the Defence team for Charles BLÉ GOUDÉ with re-issued metadata in relation to 668 documents previously disclosed as incriminatory material,<sup>4</sup> 66 items previously disclosed as potentially exonerating<sup>5</sup> and 1380 items previously disclosed pursuant to rule 77 of the Rules.<sup>6</sup> The metadata was re-issued with less redactions.
3. The disclosed material was provided in a format that complies with the eCourt protocol as approved in this case.<sup>7</sup>
