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Introduction

1. The Prosecution submits an amended list of witnesses to be called during the first and second evidentiary blocks, further to the order of Trial Chamber VI (“Chamber”).¹

Procedural History

2. On 10 April 2015, the Prosecution filed a list of witnesses it intended to call until 16 July 2015, in order of appearance (“First List”),² as instructed by the Chamber.³
3. On 8 June 2015, the Prosecution filed a request to vary the order of appearance of witnesses from that set out in the First List.⁴
4. On 22 June 2015, the Chamber ordered the Prosecution to file an amended list of witnesses to be called during the first and second evidentiary blocks by 24 June 2015.⁵
5. The Prosecution inadvertently overlooked this deadline and seeks to file its amended list of witnesses one day after the deadline set out by the Chamber.

Confidentiality

6. This annex to this filing is classified as “Confidential”, pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) and (2) of the Regulations of the Court, as it contains information which could impact the security of Prosecution witnesses and further to previous filings and decisions bearing the same confidentiality classification.

Prosecution’s Submissions

7. The Prosecution submits an amended list of the witnesses it intends to call during the first evidentiary block scheduled to run from 24 August until 8 September 2015 and during the second evidentiary block scheduled to run from 19 October until 20 November 2015.⁶
8. Further to the Chamber’s order,⁷ the Prosecution has limited the witnesses it intends to call in the second evidentiary block to four as this exhausts the remaining witnesses listed in the First List.
