Introduction

1. The Prosecution submits a further amended list of witnesses to be called during the second evidentiary block, following the instruction of Trial Chamber VI (“Chamber”).

Procedural History

2. On 25 June 2015, the Prosecution filed a list of witnesses to called during the first and second evidentiary blocks.¹
3. That same day, by way of an email to the Parties and participants, the Chamber invited the Prosecution to file a further amended list of witnesses providing for the appearance of additional witnesses during the second evidentiary block scheduled to run from 19 October to 20 November 2015.²

Confidentiality

4. This annex to this filing is classified as “Confidential”, pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) and (2) of the Regulations of the Court, as it contains information which could impact the security of Prosecution witnesses and further to previous filings and decisions bearing the same confidentiality classification.

Prosecution's Submissions

5. The Prosecution submits a further amended list of the witnesses it intends to call during the second evidentiary block scheduled to run from 19 October until 20 November 2015.³ For ease of reference, the Prosecution has also reproduced the list of witnesses it intends to call during the first evidentiary block.
6. The Prosecution has previously provided an estimate of the duration of time it anticipates will be required to conduct its examination of each witness.⁴ For scheduling purposes, the Prosecution has assumed a roughly equal amount of time will be required by the Defence and, where applicable the Legal Representatives of Victims, to conduct their respective examinations.
