I. Notification

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding incriminating evidence disclosed to the Defence teams of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Jean-Jacques Mangenda Kabongo, Fidèle Babala Wandu, and Narcisse Arido on 26 June 2015. Some of these materials are being disclosed or re-disclosed with redactions in compliance with the 22 May 2015 Protocol establishing a redaction regime¹ (“Redaction Protocol”).

II. Confidentiality

2. The Prosecution requests that Annex A appended to this Report be received as “Confidential”, as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. Disclosure of evidence

3. *Confidential* Annex A to this filing lists the disclosed incriminating evidence, including (i) previously disclosed documents, which are being re-disclosed with some redactions lifted in compliance with the Trial Chamber’s Decision,² (ii) previously disclosed transcripts and translations of intercepted communications,³ (iii) audio files to which the Defence was provided access on 19 May 2014⁴ and the corresponding transcripts and translations, (iv) a document received from a State authority in response to a Request for Assistance, (v) documents recently released to
