I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) herewith submits the report for evidence disclosed to the Defence team of Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo on 26 June 2015 pursuant to rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.¹ This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.²

2. In accordance with the Trial Chamber III’s decision,³ the Prosecution disclosed additional rule 77 documents of interviews conducted with Defence witnesses within the context of investigations pursuant to article 70 of the Rome Statute. The evidence disclosed consists of three lesser redacted versions of witness statements and transcripts that were previously provided to the Defence.

II. Request for Confidentiality

3. The Prosecution requests that Annex A appended to this communication be received by the Chamber as “Confidential”, as it relates to confidential evidence disclosed *inter partes*.
