I. Notification

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding incriminating evidence disclosed to the Defence teams of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Jean-Jacques Mangenda Kabongo, Fidèle Babala Wandu, and Narcisse Arido on 30 June 2015. Some of these materials are being disclosed with redactions in compliance with the 22 May 2015 Protocol establishing a redaction regime¹ (“Redaction Protocol”).

II. Confidentiality

2. The Prosecution requests that Annexes A and B appended to this Report be received as “Confidential”, as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. Disclosure of evidence

3. *Confidential* Annex A to this filing lists the disclosed incriminating evidence, including (i) previously disclosed audio files and their corresponding log information, transcripts and translations,² (ii) transcripts and translations of audio files previously disclosed as INCRIM,³ (iii) a document received from a State authority in response to a Request for Assistance, (iv) reports on telecommunication contacts between the Accused and Defence witnesses in the *Bemba* case,⁴ (v) and open source documents.
