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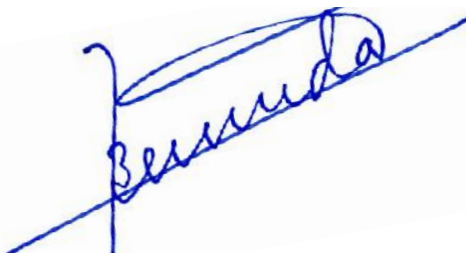

Introduction

1. On 24 June 2015, the Single Judge ordered the Parties and participants to indicate if the documents identified in Annex C of submission ICC-02/11-01/15-101 could be transferred to the joint case record.¹ The Single Judge also ordered that the filing party or participant “provide specific and detailed reasons for 'confidential, *ex parte*' classification and simultaneously file 'public redacted' and/or 'confidential redacted' versions notified to all parties and participants”.²

Submissions

2. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) has reviewed the documents in Annex C of submission ICC-02/11-01/15-101 and submits that they should all be transferred in the case record with the same confidentiality level.
3. It is further submitted that the Legal Representatives of victims should also be given access to all confidential documents of Annex C to which they do not currently have access.
