I. Introduction

1. Pursuant to Trial Chamber VII's order setting a trial date,¹ the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submitted on 30 June 2015 its (i) list of witnesses (Annex A); and (ii) list of evidence on which it intends to rely at trial (Annex B).² In furtherance of the Chamber's authorisation to add annexes 2 and 4 to one of the Independent Counsel reports to its list of evidence,³ the Prosecution hereby submits an updated version thereof.
