INFORMS the Chamber that EVD numbers have been attributed to the items;⁴

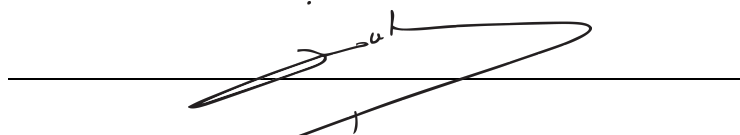
