1. Pursuant to Trial Chamber VII's order setting a trial date,¹ the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submitted on 30 June 2015 its (i) list of witnesses; and (ii) list of evidence ("LoE") on which it intends to rely at trial.² In furtherance of the Chamber's authorisation³ to add the Contact List annexed to one of the Independent Counsel's reports to its LoE,⁴ the Prosecution hereby submits an updated version thereof including this Contact List.⁵

2. In this updated version, the Prosecution also adds two items which were inadvertently left out.⁶ Adding these two items, which are only the audio version of transcripts and translations already included in the LoE, causes no prejudice to the Defence because they do not contain new information.⁷ The Prosecution, therefore, seeks the Chamber's authorisation to add these two items to its updated LoE (Annex A).

3. Confidential Annex A contains the Prosecution's updated LoE.⁸ The LoE now contains 2 276 exhibits on which the Prosecution intends to rely at trial.
