I. Notification

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding incriminating and rule 77 materials disclosed to the Defence teams of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Jean-Jacques Mangenda Kabongo, Fidèle Babala Wandu, and Narcisse Arido on 31 July 2015. Some of the materials are being disclosed with redactions in compliance with the 22 May 2015 Protocol establishing a redaction regime (“Redaction Protocol”).¹

II. Confidentiality

2. The Prosecution requests that Annexes A and B appended to this Report be received as “Confidential”, as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. Disclosure of evidence

3. *Confidential* Annex A to this filing lists the disclosed incriminating evidence, which includes 31 documents containing: (i) 15 transcriptions of witness statements, (ii) one witness summary, (iii) one statement of limited use signed by the witness,² and (iv) 14 previously disclosed documents, for which redactions have been lifted.³
