THE REGISTRAR of the International criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the “*Decision on objections concerning access to confidential material on the case record*”¹ (the “First Decision”) issued by the Single Judge of Trial Chamber I (the “Single Judge”) on 24 June 2015;

NOTING the “*Second decision on objections concerning access to confidential material on the case record*”² (the “Second Decision”) issued by the Single Judge on 21 July 2015;

NOTING rules 15 and 137 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 23bis (1) of the Regulations of the Court and regulations 20, 21 and 22 of the Regulations of the Registry;

CONSIDERING that the Single Judge, in its First Decision, directed: “*the Registry to transfer all ‘confidential, ex parte’ documents on the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case records to the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record (the “joined case”) subject to the same classification and level of access*”³;

CONSIDERING that the Single Judge also directed “*the Registry to transfer all ‘under seal’ documents on the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case records to the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record as ‘under seal, ex parte’ (only those parties and participants that currently have access)*”⁴;

CONSIDERING that the Single Judge directed “*the Registry to transfer the documents listed in Annexes A⁵ and B⁶ to the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record as ‘confidential, ex parte’ (only those parties and participants that currently have access)*”⁷;

CONSIDERING that the Single Judge directed “*the Registry to transfer all other ‘confidential’ documents on the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case records (other than those identified in Annexes A, B and C) to the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record as ‘confidential’*”⁸;

CONSIDERING that in its Second Decision, the Single Judge directed “*the Registry to transfer all Annex C Documents to the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record as ‘confidential’*”⁹;

INFORMS the Single Judge that the Registry has transferred all confidential *ex parte* records from the Laurent Gbagbo and Charles Blé Goudé cases to the joined case subject to the same classification and the same level of access;

INFORMS the Single Judge that the Registry has transferred all Under Seal documents from the Laurent Gbagbo and Charles Blé Goudé cases to the joined case, as ‘Under Seal, *ex parte*’, subject to the same level of access;

INFORMS the Single Judge that the Registry has transferred the documents listed in Annexes A and B of the Decision to the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record as ‘confidential, *ex parte*’, subject to the same level of access;

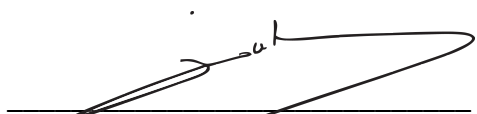

INFORMS the Single Judge that the Registry has transferred all other confidential documents from the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case records (other than those identified in Annexes A, B and C of the Decision) to the joined case record as 'confidential', adjusting the level of access;

INFORMS the Single Judge that the Registry has transferred the documents listed in Annex C as 'Confidential' in the Gbagbo and Blé Goudé case record;

TRANSMITS to the Single Judge the below annexes:

- As Annex A, Under Seal *Ex parte* Registry only, as it refers to documents classified as such, an Index of the documents transferred from the Laurent Gbagbo case to the joined case;
- As Annex B, Confidential *Ex Parte* Registry only, as it refers to documents classified as such, an Index of the documents transferred from the Charles Blé Goudé case to the joined case.
