Submissions

1. On 8 September 2015, the Defence requested the Panel to extend the page limit for its written submissions on Germain Katanga's sentence review from 10 to 25 pages.¹

2. The Prosecution does not oppose the Defence's Request. If the Panel is minded to extend the page limit, and in line with the Panel's Order of 13 August 2015 allotting all Parties and participants the identical number of pages for their written submissions,² the Prosecution requests the Panel's permission to make written submissions of the same length as that of the Defence.
