NOTING articles 43 and 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”), regulations 23*bis*, 67 and 69 of the Regulations of the Court (the “Regulations”) and 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the *Code of Professional Conduct for counsel*¹ (the “Code”);

3. Mr Bahougne executed the solemn undertakings in conformity with articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code on 8 September 2015 (Annex II);

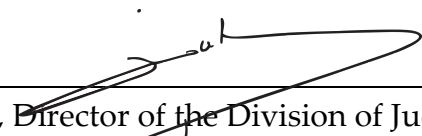
