I. Notice of Compliance

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") hereby notifies Trial Chamber VII ("Chamber") of its compliance with the Chamber's 10 September Decision,¹ as set out below.

A. Compliance

2. The Prosecution considers that paragraph 13 of the Chamber's 10 September Decision is constrained to the "intercepted data and communications".² Since the Prosecution obtained intercepted communications solely from The Netherlands, its disclosure obligations in respect of the Requests for Assistance to the Dutch authorities concerning intercepted data and communications have been discharged through its 28 August 2015 disclosure.³ The Prosecution also incorporates herein its notice of compliance of 10 September 2015.⁴

II. Confidentiality

3. This Notice is filed as "Confidential" as it refers to filings of the same designation and to *inter partes* communications. A public redacted version of the Notice will be filed.
