NOTING article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules"), regulations 23*bis*, 67 and 69 of the Regulations of the Court (the "Regulations") and regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel¹ (the "Code");

HEREBY INFORMS Trial Chamber VII (the "Chamber") as follows:

1. On 29 September 2015, the Registrar appointed Mr Marc Nève as the legal adviser to witness P-0261 pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules.²
2. On the same day, Mr Nève was provided with electronic access to the statements and transcripts of interviews of witness P-0261, via a secure channel, in order to maintain at all times due respect for confidentiality.³
3. Mr Nève executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code on 29 September 2015.⁴

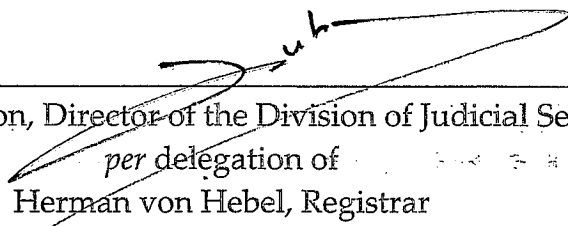
