NOTING the Registry’s *Ex parte* Transmission to the Chamber of the unredacted consolidated versions of the Applications, including the supporting documents attached to the Applications, notified on 17 September 2015, (the “Second Transmission”);³

NOTING the Chamber’s instructions of 30 September 2015 to the Registry to transmit the supporting documents pertaining to the Applications, to the Defence with any necessary redactions,⁴ and in unredacted form to the Prosecutor,⁵ no later than 7 October 2015;

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16, 85 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (the “Regulations”);

CONSIDERING that the Prosecutor has been given access by the Registry to the Second Transmission, in accordance with the Chamber’s instructions;⁶
