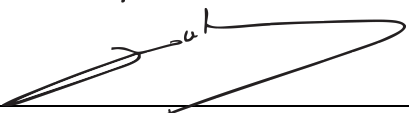
NOTING article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”), regulations 23*bis*, 67 and 69 of the Regulations of the Court (the “Regulations”), regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel¹ (the “Code”);

HEREBY INFORMS Trial Chamber VII (the “Chamber”) as follows:

1. On 6 October 2015, the Registry appointed Ms Karine Doucerain as the legal adviser to witness P-0260 pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules;²
2. On the same day, Ms Doucerain was provided with electronic access to the statements and transcripts of interviews of witness P-0260, *via* a secure channel, in order to maintain at all times due respect for confidentiality;³
3. Ms Doucerain discharged the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code on 5 October 2015.⁴
