I. Notification

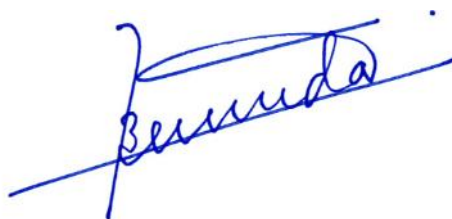
