Introduction

1. On 12 October 2015, the Single Judge exercising the function of the Pre-Trial Chamber ("Chamber") ordered the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") to inform the Chamber and the Defence, no later than 23 October 2015, of the documents that it intends to use during the examination of each witness who will be giving testimony under the provisions of article 56 of the Rome Statute in November 2015.¹ The Prosecution hereby complies with that order.

Confidentiality

2. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court, the Prosecution files this application and its Annex as "confidential" for the reasons set out at paragraphs 10, 11 and 12 of the Second Prosecution application to the Pre-Trial Chamber to preserve evidence and take measures under article 56 of the Rome Statute of 2 October 2015.²

3. The Prosecution intends to rely upon the 60 items listed in Annex A during examination in chief of the six witnesses. 17 of these items have already been disclosed. However 35 items, most of which have recently been collected, will be disclosed in the next week.
