NOTING Trial Chamber VI’s (the “Chamber”) First decision on victims’ participation in trial proceedings notified on 6 February 2015 (the “First Participation Decision”)¹ and its Fifth decision on victims’ participation in trial proceedings (the “Fifth Participation Decision”) notified on 16 November 2015;²

NOTING article 68 (1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 89(1) and 91(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23 *bis* and 86(8) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber in paragraph 24(ii) of the First Participation Decision ordered the Registry to assess the applications into three groups³ on the basis of guidance provided by the Chamber in Section III(B) of the Decision;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber in paragraph 3 of the Fifth Participation Decision ordered the Registry to transmit application a/00249/13 to the parties, in redacted form if appropriate, under Group C and invited the parties to file their observations thereon by 30 November 2015;

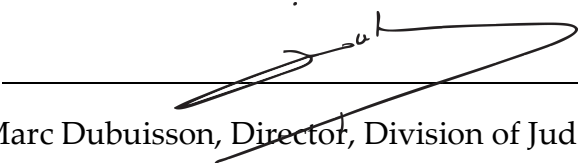
