I. SUBMISSION

1. The Defence for Dominic Ongwen ('Defence') communicated the remaining evidence for which it wishes to use during the Confirmation of Charges Hearing to the Prosecution yesterday.¹ Because of technical errors outside the control of the Defence and Prosecution, it was re-disclosed this morning.
