Document to be notified in accordance with Regulation 31 of the Regulations of the Court to:

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1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) informs Trial Chamber III that after filing its “Prosecution’s Response to ‘Defence Request for disclosure of further material’” (“Prosecution response”),¹ the Prosecution realised that it is necessary to make the following amendment to it.

- a) Footnote 19 of the Prosecution response² lists three items, as disclosed materials originating from the Prosecution’s contacts with Defence Witness 55 (“D-55”) in the context of both the main case and the Article 70 case. Due to an oversight, the first item - CAR-OTP-0056-0315 - which is a statement given by Prosecution Witness 213, was erroneously included as a statement given by D-55. The Prosecution hereby clarifies that it recorded no statement from D-55 in the main case. The Prosecution states that, with regard to materials originating from its contacts with D-55, it has already complied with its disclosure obligations by disclosing in this case: CAR-OTP-0074-0860, D-55’s statement to the [REDACTED] in the context of the Article 70 investigation and CAR-OTP-0074-0710, [REDACTED].

2. The Prosecution hereby confirms and reiterates all its remaining submissions contained in the Prosecution response.
