I. INTRODUCTION

1. Pursuant to Trial Chamber VII's order setting a trial date,¹ the Arido Defence ("Defence") submits its (i) list of witnesses (Annex A); and (ii) list of evidence on which it intends to rely at trial (Annex B).

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. Pursuant to Regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court ('RoC') and Regulation 24 of the Regulations of the Registry ('RoR'), the Defence list of witnesses is submitted as "Confidential" since Annex A refers to identifying information about Defence witnesses.

3. Annex B is also classified as "Confidential", as it relates to evidentiary material of the same designation.

III. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

4. On 3 November 2015, the Chamber issued a decision regarding directions on defence presentation of evidence. In particular, this decision established a disclosure deadlines and a deadline for notification of a final list of witnesses and evidence.²

5. The Chamber issued a subsequent decision on 9 December 2015. The Single Judge accorded a limited extension of time. The lists which were scheduled to be provided by the 7 January 2016 were extended until 21 January 2016.³

IV. SUBMISSION

6. Confidential Annex A contains the Defence's list of witnesses.

7. The Defence intends to call certain witnesses who previously did and did not testify for the Defence in ICC-01/05-01/08 ("Main Case"). These witnesses, indicated in Annex A, who testified with protective measures in the Main Case continue to benefit from the measures in these proceedings pursuant to Regulation 42 of the Regulations of the Court.

8. Confidential Annex B contains the Defence's list of evidence. The list contains 94 exhibits on which the Defence intends to rely at trial.
