The Defence for Mr. Jean-Jacques Mangenda (“the Defence”) submits this Communication Report regarding Rule 78 materials disclosed on 19 January 2016 and 21 January 2016 to the Office of the Prosecutor and the Defence teams of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Fidèle Babala Wandu and Narcisse Arido.
