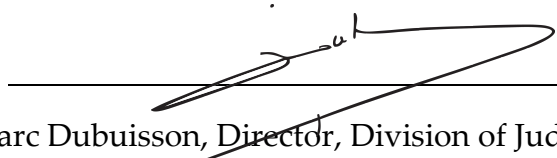

Introduction

1. On 24 January 2012, Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Pre-Trial Chamber”) ordered the Registry’s Victims Participation and Reparations Section (“VPRS”) to report every three months on the applications received in the Situation in Libya (“the Situation”);¹
2. The Registry hereby submits its sixteenth periodic report in the Situation.

Current status of applications for participation

3. To date there are no judicial proceedings in which the Pre-Trial Chamber has determined that victims may participate in relation to the Situation.
4. Since the Registry’s Tenth Periodic Report submitted on 24 July 2014 (the “Tenth Periodic Report”),² there have been no new developments concerning the status of applications for participation.
5. The information presented in the Tenth Periodic Report thus reflects the current status of victims’ applications received in relation to the Situation.
