Introduction

1. On 3 September 2015, Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) directed the Parties and the Legal Representative of Victims (LRV) to notify any material they intend to use in the course of their opening statements (“the material”) to the Chamber, Parties and the LRV, eight days prior to the commencement of trial.¹
2. On 19 January 2016 the Single Judge authorised the Parties and the LRV to notify the material by 25 January 2016.²

3. Following the Chamber’s instructions, the Office of the Prosecutor notifies the Chamber, parties and the LRV of the material to be used in the course of the opening statements by way of a list of electronic registration numbers (“ERNs”) which can be found in Annex A to this filing.
