Introduction

1. By way of this filing, the Registry informs the Chamber of the appointment of Mr Marc Nève as Legal Advisor to Witness P-0017, pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”).

Applicable Law

2. Article 68 of the Rome Statute; rules 21 and 74 of the Rules; regulations 23*bis*, 67 and 69 of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel¹ (the “Code”);

Classification

3. The present notification, along with Annex II, is classified as public; Annex I is classified as confidential, pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) RoC, as it contains the private contact details of Mr Nève.

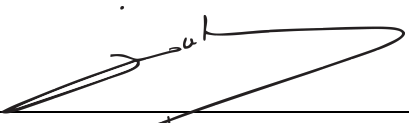
Submissions

4. On 4 January 2016, the Registrar appointed Mr Marc Nève as the legal adviser to Witness P-0017 pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules (Annex I).
5. Mr Nève was duly provided with electronic access to the statements and transcripts of interviews of Witness P-0017, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain due respect for confidentiality at all times.²
6. Mr Nève previously executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code on 29 September 2015 (Annex II).
