CONSIDERING Mr. Gbagbo’s consent, with reference to *Status conference and hearing on detention*, to release relevant medical information concerning his health, as annexed hereto;

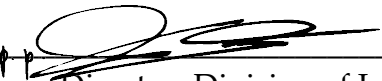
