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Prosecution's Report

1. In the "Decision on the 'Prosecution's application under article 53(3)(f) [sic] to apply redactions to documents obtained under article 54(3)(e)'" ("2 March Decision"),¹ the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") was ordered "to file in the record of the case, by 9 March 2016, a report on the status of disclosure of documents obtained on the condition of confidentiality under article 54(3)(e) of the Statute".²
2. In compliance with the 2 March Decision, the Prosecution informs the Chamber that, since its last update, it has obtained consent to lift article 54(3)(e) restrictions from all but one of the information providers in this case. This means that following the 2 March Decision, only 2 documents, amounting to 11 pages, remain affected by article 54(3)(e) restrictions. To date, article 54(3)(e) restrictions have been lifted from 6,068 documents, amounting to 47,181 pages.
3. The Prosecution continues to take steps to locate and consult with the final information provider responsible for material affected by article 54(3)(e).
