I. Introduction

1. In accordance with the Trial Chamber III's order,¹ the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits the report for evidence disclosed to the Defence team of Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo on 15 April 2016 pursuant to rule 76(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.² This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.³

2. The evidence disclosed relates to the Prosecution's request to call an expert witness to testify on matters relevant to the sentencing of Mr Bemba.⁴
